Four (4) years ago City of De Pere voters passed a referendum to build a new pool complex in VFW Park. Soon after the Post was contacted by the city parks department regarding upgrading the existing VFW Park memorial to veterans. Pictured to the right is what the memorial looked like then.

After 1 year of planning a new larger memorial was designed by our Post and accepted by the city. We then gathered community support to pay for the new \$15,000++ memorial – had great success and the new monument was ordered by the city.

Memorial Day 2022 – Week and Month activities:
