For this to happen a bill for your financial basic need is required to be submitted with the application along with a copy of the veterans DD214 or a copy of the veterans most recent duty assignment orders.

# VFW Post 2113 supporting our adopted units deployed soldiers with care packages

In April and May 2023 soldiers from our adopted military unit – the 432<sup>nd</sup> Civil Affairs Battalion (CA BN) based out of the US Army Reserve Center in Green Bay – were deployed overseas to provide support to our NATO partners with the on-going Ukraine conflict. Upon arrival overseas they were broken down into seven (7) support detachments. The Post and Auxiliary are now working in partnership with other community businesses/organizations and will be mailing care packages to the soldiers at each of those 7 locations.

- COMPLETED August 12, 2023 partnered with the 432<sup>nd</sup> Soldier and Family Readiness Group (SFRG) for collection and packing of care package items, then mailed the 14 care packages on Monday, August 14, 2023
- <u>PENDING</u> September 16, 2023 partnering with the 8<sup>th</sup> VFW District for collection and packing of care package items, then mailing the packages on Monday, September 18, 2023
- <u>PENDING</u> October 2, 2023 partnering with the Green Bay Country Club and their annual Veterans Golf Outing for collection and packing of care package items, then mailing the packages on Tuesday, October 3, 2023
- <u>PENDING</u> November 10, 2023 partnering with the Wrightstown American Legion Post 436 and the Wrightstown School District's annual Veterans Day celebrations for collecting and packing care package items, then mailing the packages on Monday, November 13, 2023.
- <u>PENDING</u> November 30, 2023 Christmas care packages partnering with the 432<sup>nd</sup> Soldier and Family Readiness Group (SFRG) for the collecting and packing care package items and Christmas cards from the soldier's families, then mailing the packages on Friday, December 1, 2023.


## **Auxiliary VFW Post 2113 Membership Information**

## **VFW Department of Wisconsin Student Veterans of Foreign Wars (SVFW)**



## Message from the Commander, VFW Post 2113

My fellow veterans,

On September 15, 2023 the nation will once again honor our missing in action on National POW/MIA Recognition Day. While it is our everlasting hope that all of the wartime missing will eventually be recovered and honored, that will not be the case as hundreds of US Navy and US Merchant Marine sailors, U.S. Army and US Marine Corps soldiers have been lost at sea and will never be recovered. The best estimates show the still missing servicemembers number = 4,400 from WWI; 72,220 from WWII; 7,497 from the Korean War; 1,579 from the Vietnam War and 132 Cold War and the Gulf War actions.



That is why VFW Post 2113 and the VFW Department of Wisconsin strongly supports the University of Wisconsin Madison POW/MIA Project (<a href="https://mia.biotech.wisc.edu/">https://mia.biotech.wisc.edu/</a>). Their mission is to recover missing U.S. military personnel from past global conflicts. Prime example - US Army CPL Don DuPont, a Korean War MIA, FOUND on 7/27/2018 and IDENTIFIED on 1/24/2023 and returned home to WI - <a href="https://fox11online.com/news/state/remains-of-wisconsin-soldier-missing-since-korean-war-return-home-north-korea-army-donald-donny-dupont-alma-center-eau-claire-fairchild-cleveland-cemetery#
